This paper has been written for dissemination purposes of this particular extra intellectual output.

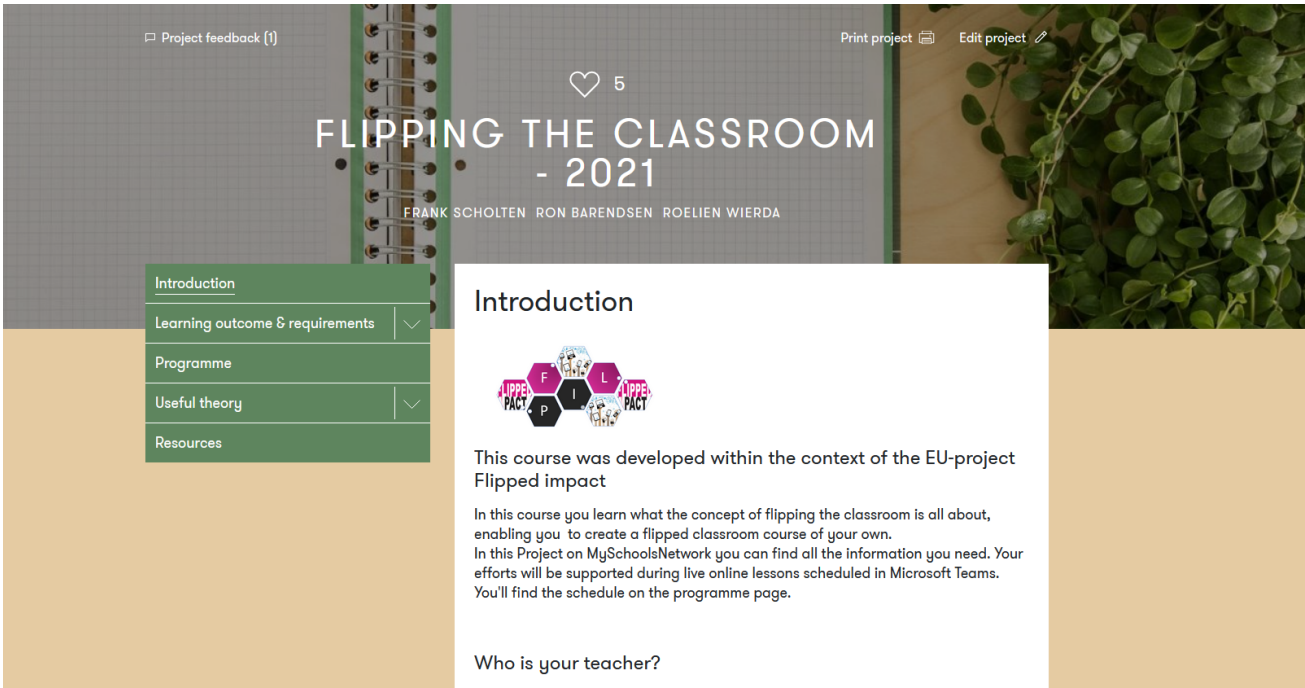
