

Learning outcomes



 You will be able to ask yes/no questions and to answer yes/no questions.




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

 - React accordingly to whatever has been said;


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You will learn words to describe your future job, living place, dream holiday and pet. You will be able to ask yes/no questions and to answer yes/no questions.



Social interactions - the future






Social interactions - the Past
